“Since 1993, Mosaic Family Services has been a safe haven for survivors of human rights abuses, serving refugees, survivors of domestic violence, and survivors of human trafficking. Our mission is to transform, empower, and rebuild our client’s lives through culturally-competent services. Mosaic provides case management, advocacy, counseling, legal representation, children's advocacy, 24-hour assistance, emergency safe shelter, transitional housing, and interpretation. Our highly trained, multilingual staff provides case management, advocacy, counseling, short and long-term housing services, legal services, children’s services, and interpretation. Mosaic operates under a one-stop shop modality, striving to meet clients’ needs within one agency. The refugees and survivors we serve receive a full range of support and avoid service gaps created by working with multiple organizations. We partner with local and federal law enforcement, hospitals, social services and community organizations to help clients access services and achieve self-sufficiency. Mosaic prioritizes hiring staff that reflect and/or have lived experience of vulnerable populations whenever possible. Mosaic has survivors, refugees, immigrants, and first generation Americans within our staff, including 3 former clients. Whenever we hire staff who speak a certain language, we often see a direct increase in survivors who speak the same language and/or from the same cultural community. Our staff represents many cultures and every major faith, and has fluency in 30 languages, including Arabic, Bengali, Bosnian, Burmese, Chin, Croatian, Dari, Farsi, Fe’fe’, French, Hindi, Ibo, Italian, Kikuyu, Korean, Kurdish, Laotian, Mandarin, Matu, Nepali, Pashto, Serbian, Somali, Spanish, Swahili, Thai, Turkish, Ukrainian, Urdu, and Vietnamese. Our programs reach and serve clients who would not be served at traditional shelters, counseling centers, or legal aid organizations.”

To date, Hagar’s Heart has distributed over 5,500 "I See You" boxes and established in-shelter programs and community initiatives like Revive & Thrive.
